Michigan Public Act No. 389: A new law for skaters and skating centers

Duties and responsibilities of roller skaters

While in a roller skating area, each roller skater shall do all of the following:

- Maintain reasonable control of his or her speed and course at all times.
- Read all posted signs and warnings.
- Maintain a proper lookout to avoid other skaters and objects.
- Accept the responsibility for knowing the range of his or her own ability to negotiate the intended direction of travel while on roller skates and to skate within the limits of that ability.
- Refrain from acting in a manner which may cause injury to others.

Each person who participates in roller skating accepts the danger that inheres in that activity insofar as the dangers are obvious and necessary. Those dangers include, but are not limited to, injuries that result from collisions with other roller skaters or other spectators, injuries that result from falls, and injuries which involve objects or artificial structures properly within the intended travel of the roller skater which are not otherwise attributable to the operator's breach of his or her common law duties.
